The COVID-19 pandemic has provided an exciting opportunity for our teachers to develop new ways of delivering high quality learning for our students with technology. We want to continue to build on this expertise to enhance our curriculum offer for our school communities. It is our vision and determination to enable every child to have access to affordable, high quality devices which they can use to support homework or any possible future distance learning. Using IT safely and effectively is an essential part of everyday life for our students and we are committed to equipping them with these skills for life. Should we find ourselves in another lock down situation, we will be delivering a high-quality remote curriculum immediately. We are passionate about ensuring that as many students as possible can have full access to this provision.

THE EQUIPMENT ON OFFER

We have selected a Chromebook with flip and touchscreen functionality. This Chromebook is best suited to students at our school. The Chromebook is specifically designed for student use with a ruggedised outer casing and enhanced specification to ensure they can withstand all functional requirements.

Each device is supplied with a 3-year warranty and a 3-year Repair Service. In the event of fault, accidental damage or theft you will log the support ticket via the online portal and the faulty/damaged device will be collected, repaired and returned at no additional charge.

We have opted for the latest generation Chromebook with increased processing power in order to improve the experience for our students. With Google Auto Update support until June 2029 we believe that this Chromebook offers best value for money for our families. It also comes with the integrated Digital Pen as standard for enhanced user functionality.

WHY CHROMEBOOKS?

Chromebooks are extremely secure, easy to use and facilitate both independent study and online collaboration. Through the use of Google Apps for Education & Office 365 we can further improve student engagement, and open the door to learning.

Using Chromebooks with the Management Console ensures that all students are able to access the same resources and applications, wherever they are in the world, and enables teachers to deliver the curriculum in the most exciting and engaging way.

Frequently Asked Questions

How long can I spread payments over?

If your child is in Year 7 or 8 you can choose to spread the payments over 12, 24 or 36 months. For Year 9, you can choose to spread the payment over 12 or 24 months. For Year 10 you can choose to spread the payments over 12. For Year 11, you can make a single up-front payment only.

For all Year Groups, you can make a single up-front payment if you prefer not to spread the cost.

Why are we using a leasing scheme?

The benefits of using a leasing scheme are:

- A lower monthly payment is available as you can pay for the device over a longer period of time.
- Device repair service, with guaranteed repair or replacement for the full 36 months at no additional charge to the parent.
- Improved brand quality offered through Lenovo.
- Full ownership of the device once final payment is made.

Will there be any credit checks?

No, everyone is approved.

How will I make payments?

Payments will be made via Direct Debit using an online portal provided and administered by Freedom Tech. You will also have the ability to pay a single one off payment if you would prefer not to spread the cost.

What happens if I miss a payment, can no longer afford the device or my child leaves the school?

You must return the device to the school, or alternatively pay the outstanding payments to take ownership of the device.

When will I receive the device?

The ordering window has now opened and orders need to be placed by 10th December at the latest. Your first direct debit will be collected on 25th December (or next working day) and the Chromebook will be delivered to school for collection in mid-January – subject to stock availability.

Are Chromebooks secure?

Yes. Chromebooks are designed with multiple layers of security to keep them safe from viruses and malware without any additional security software. A full 10% of boot time is dedicated to re-verifying that the device has not been tampered with, so every time you power on a Chromebook, your security is checked. Google also adheres to all data policies including GDPR and does not share data with any third parties.

How have pupils at Church Stretton benefited from the last two years of the programme?

We have seen pupils benefit from having a device to support distance learning and homework tasks. The devices link to the school ICT systems allowing them to quickly continue the learning journey at home and support their independence.

Will I be able to use the device in school?

To begin with any device purchased is to be used at home only to support home learning or any future distance learning. In the future we will look to allow students to bring these devices into school, but currently we are not offering this provision.

How will Chromebooks enhance learning from the students?

The Chromebook's will work alongside the students Microsoft accounts at school and will enhance their learning. Examples include:

- Create, share and collaborate using Office 365 tools such as SharePoint, Outlook and MS Teams.
- Access Go4 Schools Homework and documents with ease.
- Use excellent learning resources from our web-based tools, including up to date and relevant e-textbooks, where appropriate.
- Use digital tools to support research and writing. For example, academic bibliography and citation tools, read aloud and voice recognition tools to promote independent learning.
- Think and behave creatively across their subjects using Cloud Apps for design, planning, animation, mind-mapping, image editing, sound editing, video recording, etc.
- Use subject related Apps.
- Greater opportunities for differentiation
- Effective assessment for learning to aid long term planning based on students' learning.

Why have we selected Chromebooks?

There is a wide range of tablet and laptop-style devices available on the market. We have conducted extensive research when considering the type of device that would be best suited to students in our school.

A Chromebook looks like a laptop in appearance, but operates in a different way with students accessing services and Apps online. The Chromebook operating system is produced by Google, who provide a wealth of Apps and services specifically designed to support students in education. Chromebook devices boot-up in a matter of seconds and have a battery life that lasts up to eight hours, dependent on use. Chromebook devices will be managed by Freedom Tech to ensure that access is safe and secure.

Can my child put their own content on to the Chromebook (e.g. music, video, Apps)?

Yes, your child should treat the Chromebook as their own. Therefore, students are able to download non-educational Apps to enjoy at home provided they are appropriate in content.

Who owns the Chromebook?

The device belongs to Freedom Tech whilst the device is subject to a payment plan. The student will be able to use the device 24/7. The student will own the device once the final payment has been made.

Could we 'opt out' of the scheme all together?

We truly believe the introduction of a school ready Chromebook and the use of Google suite tools will enhance learning and teaching. It will enable teachers to utilise technology to benefit students' learning and therefore ultimately their progress.
