Dear Parents/Carers,

Re: KS3 Core Examinations – 21st – 23rd June 2023

The KS3 Core Examinations will be taking place between 21st and 23rd June 2023. These exams are in English, maths and science, and follow on from the Foundation Examinations your child(ren) completed earlier in the academic year. The Core Examinations will allow you and your child(ren) to see where their strengths lie in the Core subjects and are an important indicator of progress made by students. There will be preparation taking place in lessons, however, the expectation is that this is supplemented and supported with revision at home.

If your child is ill during the Core Examination period, please phone the school office to report their absence in the usual way. We will re-arrange any missed exams for students who are too ill to attend. I would like to reiterate the importance of thorough preparation for these examinations. We have invested in an online revision tool called Seneca Learning; your child has the log in details for this. Please encourage them to use this **along with** the other signposted revision resources on GO 4 Schools for each subject.

During the Foundation Examination periods we held launch assemblies, during which we explained to students how to plan the use of their time and ensure that they can fit in sufficient revision for each subject. There is help, support and guidance on the school website here covering how to revise, how to deal with stress and useful links to documents such as the topics covered by the exams, a blank revision planner and the exams timetable. A copy of the exam timetable and the topics covered in each subject exam are included at the end of this letter and they have both been shared with students via Go4Schools and their email accounts.

Preparation:

Students should spend one lesson preparing for the assessment. In this preparation lesson, students will:

- revise metaphor (tenor, vehicle, ground)
- **be given** the title of the poem
- **be introduced to** some of difficult vocabulary from the unseen poem (i.e. the words provided in the glossary see Appendix 1 **but not the poem itself**)
- be given some guidance on how to approach the task
