## Summary of Scheme of Delegation & Summary of Roles and Responsibilities

Governance of our schools is provided by three types of Governors:

- 1. Trustees who have overall responsibly for standards, finance, and schooling.
- 2. Members who appoint trustees, and who receive the annual accounts. They are 'Eyes on and Hands off' in approach for most of the year.
- 3. LGB Governors who work as specialists on the detail of individual schools and who know each school best.

Headteachers work with Trustees and LGB Governors according to who holds the remit. The list below is a summary of the remits of the LGB and the Trust Board. See the Scheme of Delegation and Terms of Reference for the detail and specific authorisations.
