



## Spring GCSE Exams

### Equipment List

You will need the following for your exams:

- a clear, see-through plastic bag or pencil case (without writing, symbols or pictures) to carry your stationery
- at least two BLACK writing pens (not blue or any other colour)
- two pencils (either HB or 2B)
- an eraser
- a pencil sharpener
- a ruler
- for Maths – pair compasses, protractor
- you may bring a non-programmable scientific calculator if you wish, though it is not required equipment. You **should not** bring a calculator to your Maths exam
- you may bring water with you, but it must be in a clear, transparent, unlabeled bottle
- you need to bring a face mask

Do not bring:

- a mobile phone, smart watch or any internet-enabled device
- tippex, liquid paper or correction fluid
- gel pens

Rules and Regulations during an external exam:

- as soon as you enter the exam room **you must be silent**
  - You must not speak to anyone except an invigilator
  - You should not make gestures, gesticulations or signs to other candidates
  - Do not borrow anything from another candidate during the exam
  - Do not have any internet-enabled device with you even if it's switched off

All of the above actions are considered as malpractice.

- if you require assistance during the exam, stay seated and put your hand up
- follow the invigilators' instructions carefully
- please remember that invigilators are not allowed to help you to understand the question or help you to provide an answer
- do not leave the exam room unaccompanied as you will not be allowed to return
