Gold given out. The capital, **Timbuktu**, was a centre of learning across the Islamic world. As the Mali Empire collapsed, the kingdom of Songhay grew.

## The Kingdom of Songhay



Songhay was a wealthy and well governed kingdom. In the 1440s some Portuguese arrived and started to enslave

Africans. **Leo Africanus** wrote accounts from Songhay, challenging the ideas that Africa was poor and 'uncivilised'
