We appreciate your support in helping your daughter or son to prepare effectively at home for the forthcoming GCSE exams. For Maths, we recommend:

- Reviewing completed exam papers, attempting to do corrections.
- Checking corrected answers using the mark schemes from the Maths section of <https://churchstretton.sharepoint.com> – also linked through Go4Schools Yr 11 Homework
- Attempting additional exam papers shared on <https://churchstretton.sharepoint.com>
- Checking [Hegarty Maths](#), revision guides or [mymaths](#) to support when stuck. Many of the exam papers have spreadsheet grids with the topic name for each question on [sharepoint](#), if you are unsure what topic you are stuck on.
- Use lunch support in school to get help from your Maths teachers – please bring specific questions that you are unsure about. This normally only takes a few minutes each time, and is a really effective way to improve understanding on target topics.
- Check 'my tasks' at the top of the screen on [Hegarty Maths](#), to see if you have any tasks recommended by your teacher.
- Check that you know the '[need to know](#)' formulae (not given on the exam papers) – try the self-check sheet on [sharepoint](#).

There are no grade boundaries provided for any of the exam papers. Our advice is to focus on improvement, rather than spending time speculating about what the grade boundaries might be.

After the exams, many pupils in Year 11 will have a 10 week holiday before their next course of study. Knowing that you have done your best with study preparation is a good start to this long holiday.
