YEAR 8 VISIT TO Blists Hill Friday 15th June 2018

Dear Parents/carers,

Year 8 are studying the Industrial Revolution in their History lessons. As part of this we would like to take them to visit Blists Hill Museum and the Museum of Iron, near Telford, to gain an understanding of how important Shropshire was in the development of industry in the 18th and 19th centuries.

We will leave school at approximately 9.00 and return by 3.15. We will divide the students so we can safely explore the two sites, with both groups meeting at Blists Hill for lunchtime.

As this site is mostly outdoors, and has some unpaved roads, students will need to wear suitable footwear. Due to the unpredictable nature of the weather we recommend that students bring both a waterproof coat and sun cream/sun hat. Students will need to bring a packed lunch, pens and pencils to write with and, if they wish to, a small amount of spending money (£10 maximum).

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£10** towards the costs of this trip, there is no obligation to contribute and students will not be treated any differently but please be aware that if there are insufficient contributions to cover costs the trip will not take place. If your son/daughter is eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant, please contact Mr Overton for details regarding a possible subsidy. All payments will need to be made online at www.ParentPay.com through your activated account. If you do not have access to the internet, you will need to contact the school to request a barcoded letter and pay at local stores where you see the PayPoint logo.

We would appreciate payment by Friday, 25th May 2018.
