Please note that students will need to pick one subject from each of the four option blocks listed above when the final Pathways option form is shared with them electronically on Friday 22nd April, they will also need to select a reserve subject from each block. The options we offer may be subject to change as a result of the number of students who opted for each subject, staffing changes or we may choose to offer an alternative level 2 course for a subject that matches the needs of the cohort. We will of course share any changes with you at the earliest opportunity.
