### GCSE Results Day 2020 – Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August

Dear Parents, Carers and Year 11 students,

As you are aware, due to the restrictions imposed by Covid 19, we are not in a position to hold a 'normal' results day where students can pick up envelopes from school. The safety and wellbeing of everyone is our priority and therefore students will receive results remotely this year; they will also be sent out by post.

### How will students receive results?

Results will be visible on **Go4Schools** from 9am on the 20<sup>th</sup> August. They will be displayed at the bottom of each student's profile page in a table called '**Key Grades/levels achieved'**. This will have a Year 11 section where examination results will be detailed. Results can also be seen in the '**Progress and Reports**' section on the student's page. The results will be listed as '**Actual'** grades.

Unfortunately, school cannot inform students about results by phone or by email. However, we will be posting results slips out to all students.

### **Contact with staff**

Included in the results envelope will be contact details for key staff so that students can gain any required support, help and advice. This list can also be found in the appendix to this letter.

### How grades have been awarded and post-results services

## Appendix 1: Examination results 2020 – how were grades awarded without exams? What post-results services are in place?

### Centre Assessment Grades (CAGs) and Ranks

In replacement of examination results, schools were asked to provide a Centre Assessed Grade for every student in all courses and then to rank students within each grade bracket (or across units for Btec awards).

This meant that the school had to make objective judgements to ensure that the grades suggested were as accurate a reflection as possible of the most plausible grade any student would have received had they sat their exams. This is not the same as a possible grade of course, as a number of different grades for each candidate were possible.

To fulfil this process the school used sources of evidence and data such as assessments and mock exams sat throughout the course. Judgements were moderated by use of an external source that compares schools' prior attainment in a similar way to the process being applied nationally to all schools by exam boards/Ofqual. All evidence was collated, reviewed and moderated again to ensure absolute fairness, accuracy and objectivity.

These grades and ranks were finally checked and signed off by the Head of Centre before being submitted to the appropriate exam boards.

It is important to note that Ofqual have devised a method to allow for a national standardisation across centres which will almost certainly lead to changes in grades from the ones that were originally submitted by schools. Their aim is for the national results to reflect those of the previous year to preserve the integrity of the GCSE exams. This means that irrespective of what a school entered, grades may have moved up or down in line with that schools' previous outcomes.

### **Special Consideration**

Any student who would have had Special Consideration in the summer 2020 examination series will have been granted the same entitlements from exam boards for their centre assessed grades.

### **Results and Certificates**

Examination results will be issued as normal on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August. Certificates are usually received in school in November, so students will be contacted nearer the time for collection.

#### Appeals

Normally, students can make appeals about their exam results because their scripts can be accessed and re-assessed. Centre assessed grades cannot be appealed because for this to take place, it would have to be undertaken by someone better placed than the student's teacher to judge the grade that has been identified. Ofqual have investigated this carefully and identified that there is no such person. Therefore, the only appeal that can be made about grades is if a student thinks there has been an administration error either by the school or the awarding body. Clearly, a student should raise a complaint in school or pass on evidence to an awarding body if they feel there has been malpractice.

#### **Autumn Exam Series**

An exam series will run in the autumn term (November). All subjects will be available but the normal non-exam components of a course will not be included (except for Art). Results will be out in February 2021 and whichever is the highest of the centre assessed grade or November exam result will stand. If wishing to improve a grade 3 or below in either English or Maths the centre where the student is on roll from September will be responsible for entering students in those exams.
