Jesus' Miracles

Jesus performed 3 types of Miracle, Miracles over nature such as Jesus walking on water, Miracles of healing such as Healing a blind man and Exorcisms which is the getting rid of evil spirits.

Jesus performance of miracles showed who Jesus was, the MESSIAH as John in his Gospel says "who could perform these miracles unless they had God with them". Also Jesus was living his teachings, healing someone shows "Love for your neighbour as yourself"



Jesus' Parables

Jesus had 3 main things he taught about, What the kingdom of God is like, How you can enter the Kingdom of God and that God is like a loving Father. Examples of Jesus' parables are The Parable of the Mustard Seed (Mark Ch4), The Parable of the Sower (Mark Ch 4), The Parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke Ch 10) and The Parable of the Lost Son (Luke Ch15).

The Death and Resurrection of Jesus

The of Jesus' death is called HOLY WEEK. On the Sunday now called Palm Sunday he rides into Jerusalem on a young horse fulfilling an Old Testament prophecy by Zechariah saying when the Messiah arrives he will be riding a colt in peace. On Monday Jesus goes to Judaism's Holiest place the Temple and is angry that a market was there and it was disrespecting Gods House. The Jewish leaders plot to arrest Jesus using Judas one of Jesus' disciples. On the Thursday Jesus has his last supper with his DISCIPLES the events of which are the basis of the HOLY COMMUNION service each Sunday. Jesus is found guilty of BLASPHEMY (using God's name without respect) which is punishable by death, but it is the Roman governor Pilate who send Jesus for crucifixion on what Christians call GOOD FRIDAY. Had the story stopped there we may not be talking about Jesus now. Christians believe Jesus rose from the dead by God the RESURRECTION. Christians believe Jesus died to ATONE for their SINS. God accepted this sacrifice, forgave all mans sins and by the GRACE of God continues to do so to all who are truly sorry
