<u>SANCTITY OF LIFE</u>—That life is Special, Sacred or Holy, Many religions see it as a gift of God

<u>EUTHANASIA</u> —Sometimes called assisted suicide, the killing of someone whose quality of life through illness is so poor they want to die. Euthanasia literally means good death.

<u>ABORTION</u> – the ending of a pregnancy either though the body miscarrying the baby, or by chemical or surgical means.

"You shall love your neighbour as yourself" Christians (Bible)


"Whoever kills an innocent person it is as if he has killed all of Humanity" Islam (Qur'an)
