We would like to invite you to 'attend' our Year 8 Progress Evenings. We had hoped to run these events as hybrid evenings with both in-person and video call appointments. Given the increased Covid measures the school is continuing to implement it is not possible to hold the in-person appointments for these events in school. Which means we have had to revert to the fully online video call system to allow you to meet the teachers and discuss your child's progress. We have split the Year group over two separate evenings, as many of the staff teach multiple groups, to provide you with more opportunities to meet with your child's teachers and discuss their progress. The Year 8X Progress Evening will be held on Thursday 11^{th} November between 15:30 - 18:30 and the Year 8Y Progress Evening will be held on Thursday 18^{th} November between 15:30 - 18:30.

The online booking system gives parents/carers the opportunity to choose their appointment time and they will receive an email to confirm the time with a link to access the video appointment. This of course raises questions about how the system works and what device you need to access the appointments. There is a short video showing how the process works and the best device to access meetings on here.

Appointments for the 8X evening will close on Wednesday 10th November at 16:00. Appointments for the 8Y evening will close on Wednesday 17th November at 16:00.

Parents' Guide for Booking Appointments



Step 1: Login

Fill out the details on the page then click the *Log In* button.

A confirmation of your appointments will be sent to the email address you provide.



Step 2: Select Parents' Evening

Click on the date you wish to book.

Unable to make all the dates listed? Click I am unable to attend.



Step 3: Select Booking Mode


Choose Automatic if you'd like the system to suggest the shortest possible appointment schedule based on the times you're available to attend. To pick the times to book with each teacher, choose Manual. Then press Next.

We recommend choosing the automatic booking mode when browsing on a mobile device.



Step 4: Choose Teachers

If you chose the automatic booking mode, drag the sliders at the top of the screen to indicate the earliest and latest you can attend. Select the teachers you would like to book appointments with. A green tick indicates they are selected. To de-select, click on their name.



Step 5a (Automatic): Book Appointments

If you chose the automatic booking mode, you will see provisional appointments which are held for 2 minutes. To keep them, choose Accept at the bottom left.

If it was not possible to book every selected teacher during the times you are able to attend, you can either adjust the teachers you wish to meet with and try again or switch to manual booking mode (Step 5b).



Step 5b (Manual): Book Appointments

Click any of the green cells to make an appointment. Blue cells signify where you already have an appointment. Grey cells are unavailable.

To change an appointment, delete the original by hovering over the blue box and click *Delete*. Then choose an alternate time.

You can optionally leave a message for the teacher to say what you would like to discuss or raise anything beforehand.

Once you are finished booking all appointments, at the top of the page in the alert box, press *click here* to finish the booking process.



Step 6: Finished

All your bookings now appear on the My Bookings page. An email confirmation has been sent and you can also print appointments by pressing *Print*. Click *Subscribe to Calendar* to add these and any future bookings to your calendar.

To change your appointments, click on Amend Bookings.

By joining this programme students will have a School ready device exclusively for their own use at home, with 3-year extended warranty, accidental damage, and theft insurance, both with £0 excess for a one-off payment of £471.48. Orders can be placed using the portal at www.tech4learners.co.uk, you can logon by providing your email address, the username: **CSS21** and password: **S3cure02!** The portal is open now and the deadline for orders for this round will be Wednesday 10th November and the first direct debt payment will be taken on Thursday 25th November. We would expect delivery of the devices to be in December.

Joining the programme is optional, but with the possibility that School may be required to revert to periods of remote learning we are offering parents/carers the chance to purchase a 'school ready' device that we know would have all the necessary software installed, antivirus protection and security settings to keep students safe. There is the added benefit that the School IT manager can remotely assist with any difficulties and provide updates as and when they are required. Leasing the device is an effective way to spread the cost, but will incur an increased cost, which we have broken down in the table below to show you the terms available and the additional cost incurred. The school is not making any money from the programme, our main priority is ensuring as many students as possible have suitable IT equipment that is fit for purpose and provides value for money.
