Dear Parents, Carers and Yr9 Students heading out to DRAYTON MANOR PARK on Friday 15th July.

To ensure that every student going on this trip has an enjoyable experience please could you take note of the following


- 1. In the likely event of good weather please ensure that all pupils travel with plenty of WATER to drink.
- 2. They should also wear SUNSCREEN and be able to reapply it during the day.
- 3. A HAT is advisable, as are comfortable practical shoes and sensible clothes that offer shoulders some protection against the sun or are weather appropriate in case of rain.
- 4. A small backpack to carry money/ water /sunscreen/ hat etc. Please don't send students with large amounts of money.
- 5. Due to a large number of students who have allergies to nuts please check that the snacks that your child brings on the trip DO NOT contain nuts. I need the buses to be NUT FREE ZONES. Please discuss this matter with your child. I will be asking staff to check packets on board and remove anything we are concerned about before we leave.
- 6. Equally any student who has known allergies should be responsible for bringing the required medicines/epipen/inhaler/travel sickness tablets etc. These can be kept safely by staff if they are clearly labelled with your child's name.
- 7 DIETARY CONCERNS. The students on this trip are in Year 9 and old enough to be aware of issues re dietary choices including allergies/ halal/ vegetarianism/ veganism. Please discuss this with them and ensure that they understand the need to be cautious about the foods they consume in the park and to ask questions if they are still in doubt DON'T BUY IT.
- 8. If you would like your child dropped off en route along the A49 on our return journey please ensure your child hands a signed note to this effect to Mrs Dixon on Friday 15th. Reception will not be able to process this information as they are exceptionally busy at this point in the year. So please don't ring and ask them to pass a message on.
