## Musical knowledge 1: the essentials

## Layers of sound

Melody = tune. One note at a time. Can be sung or played on an instrument.

Melody



See opposite

Chords



A bass line

Played on a low-pitched instrument such as bass guitar, cello, double bass, tuba.


4. A beat



Beat = rhythm. Played on unpitched instruments such as drums.

## Notes on a keyboard

- 1. Notes are in alphabetical order, going up to G
- 2. Say: 'C is to the left of the two black keys: C D E F G A B'



A note by itself **CANNOT** be major or minor!

- 3. Every black note has two names: sharp # and flat **b**
- 4. Flat = lower than white note
- 5. Sharp = higher than white note

## Chords


1. Chord = 2+ notes played together




2. Chords can be major or minor

Major = 4 then 3 semitones. Sounds happy

Minor = 3 then 4 semitones. Sounds sad



3. Chords are usually played on the keyboard, guitar, or ukulele.
