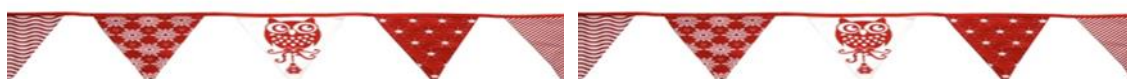
## P.T.A CRAFT FAYRE & RAFFLE

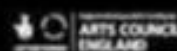
